



# BURGUNDY TOUR

5 DAYS 4 NIGHTS



# Day 1

## Arrival in Dijon and check-in at Hôtel Château de Gilly

Begin your Burgundy adventure with an arrival in Dijon, the region's historic capital. Stroll through the city center to admire its rich architectural heritage, including the Place de la Libération and the Palais des Ducs. Depart for Gilly-lès-Cîteaux and arrive at Hôtel Château de Gilly, a 4-star hotel set in a magnificent location amidst Burgundy's vineyards. Enjoy lunch at the hotel or a nearby local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit **Domaine Château Marsannay** in Marsannay-la-Côte for a wine tasting in a family-owned estate with stunning views of the vineyards. Discover typical regional wines such as Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Continue to **Domaine d'Armele & Rion** in Vosne-Romanée, a prestigious estate in the heart of the Côte de Nuits, offering a tasting of 5 to 6 wines. Learn about Burgundy's terroir. Return to Hôtel Château de Gilly for relaxation and dinner, featuring Burgundy specialties.



# Day 2

## Visits to wineries around Beaune

---

After breakfast, head to Beaune to visit the Hospices de Beaune, a must-see historical museum that offers insight into the city's history, its medieval hospitals, and its rich winemaking heritage. Late morning, tour **Domaine Château de Pommard** in Pommard, where you'll explore the cellars and taste the estate's wines, all while enjoying panoramic vineyard views. Lunch in a local restaurant. In the afternoon, visit **Domaine Château Meursault** in Meursault for a wine tasting at one of the region's most prestigious estates. Return to Beaune to visit **Moutarderie Fallot**, where you can learn about local mustard production and sample various types. It's both a delightful and educational experience. Check in at Hôtel Le Cep, a 5-star establishment in the heart of the historic city. Dinner at the hotel featuring Burgundy specialties.



# Day 3

## Excursion to Chablis and return to Beaune

After breakfast, travel to Chablis, renowned for its white wines. Explore the local market, especially lively on Sunday mornings, and visit **Chablis's historic cellars** for tastings of various crus. Lunch in a typical Chablis restaurant. In the afternoon, tour **Domaine Famille Picard** in Chassagne-Montrachet for a wine tasting and learn about the history of this winemaking family before returning to Beaune. Enjoy free time to wander Beaune's picturesque streets, visit local shops, or relax in a café. In the evening, dine at the hotel or a local restaurant to conclude the day.





## Day 4

### Visit to Cluny and return to Beaune

---

After breakfast, depart for Cluny via the Route des Grands Crus, a scenic route through renowned wine villages showcasing typical Burgundy landscapes. In Cluny, visit the **Abbey of Cluny**, once one of Europe's largest Benedictine monasteries, then have lunch at "Bistrot de Cluny," known for its traditional Burgundy cuisine. In the afternoon, explore the **Musée d'Art et d'Archéologie de Cluny** and stroll through the historic town center, with its charming alleys and medieval houses. Return to Hôtel Le Cep in Beaune for the evening.

# Day 5

## Departure from Beaune to Paris

---

After breakfast, depart Beaune for Paris,  
concluding your Burgundy tour.
